#### BRIEF DESCRIPTION

This short learning programme addressing key issues in public housing strategy supports the national objective of providing an accelerated rate of affordable housing delivery for the people of South Africa. It responds to the capacity building needs of housing departments at all tiers of government.

The course provides housing managers and officials at a strategic level an opportunity to engage in a contemporary discourse, at an advanced level, around strategic housing issues that they currently face, with a focus on identifying meaningful and practical solutions that can be applied.

#### COURSE CONTENT

- Key strategic issues affecting housing delivery
- Housing and sustainable human settlements
- The integration of housing and planning
- Housing and the changing political environment

#### LEARNING OUTCOMES

Through a process of facilitated discourse, interactive group discussions, handouts, case studies, oral reports and debate, participants should be able to:

- Debate the implications of alternative ideological approaches to housing policy and provision for developing sustainable communities
- Make recommendations to address strategic housing issues in the context of a metropolitan municipality
- Promote sustainable human settlements within the metropolitan municipality and the metropolitan housing function
- Identify and analyse opportunities for building relationships between the planning function and the housing function in housing strategy, policy and implementation

#### LEARNING ASSUMED TO BE IN PLACE

Delegates should hold a qualification at NQF level 6.

#### WHO SHOULD ENROL?

Participants must be currently employed at a strategic, senior management level in the housing function in any of the tiers of government – national, provincial or municipal.

#### ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION

This course is a short learning programme at new HEQF level 7. A certificate will be issued by the University of Johannesburg.

#### COURSE STRUCTURE AND VENUE

- 2 days full time
- Additional time to be allocated for evening assignment
- Courses will be run in Johannesburg
- Regional courses can be run on request, subject to enrolment
